#### **Helpful Terms**

#### Conservator/Guardian

A conservator or guardian is a person that is appointed by the court to arrange for the personal care or financial supervision (or both), for someone who has been found by the court to be unable to do so.

**Estate Planning** is simply the process of making it clearly known how you want your estate to be handled after you pass or if you're incapacitated and unable to handle things on your own.

### **Fiduciary**

A relationship that implies a position of trust or confidence where one person is entrusted to hold or manage property or money for another.
