## **Senior Care Management Program – Continuing Care Services**

## What is Senior Care Management?

Senior Care Management is a program of the Continuing Care Department. Social workers provide short-term care management assistance to at-risk members 65 and older and their families. Cases remain open up to 60 days depending on individual needs.

Senior Care Management provides:

- Planning for future care needs for families and patients to independently access resources and supports.
- Information and referrals to community services and resources including:
  - Home delivered meals
  - Transportation
  - Help at home
  - Financial programs and services
- Short-term counseling and education to address health and social changes affecting daily living.



## Additional Services



**Caregiver Support Groups** – for anyone providing care for an ill or elderly person. The group provides a safe and caring place to share feelings and concerns along with options and solutions for common problems. Groups are led by a social worker and/or a nurse. There is no charge.
