The program also works to support the recovery of family members and to improve their ability to support the child. Interventions include individual, group, and family therapy. The staff's expertise is in treating childhood traumatic events including neglect; physical and sexual abuse; sexual assault; domestic, school, and community violence; and natural disasters. Treatment for the psychological aspects of medical trauma and chronic pain is also available.

Community Resource Center works to end hunger, homelessness and domestic violence in North County San Diego. CRC's programs include a domestic violence emergency shelter, hotline and prevention/education outreach, a Therapeutic Children's Center, professional counseling, legal advocacy, food and nutrition distribution center, homelessness prevention and rental and housing assistance. All of CRC's programs are designed to assist participants to successfully navigate their paths of safety, stability & self-sufficiency.

Sexual Assault Response Team of San Diego County (SART)

SART is a victim-sensitive program designed to provide a team approach to responding to sexual assaults in our community. The team consists of a specially trained nurse examiner to provide an evidentiary examination and medical support, a law enforcement officer to conduct an investigation and provide emergency assistance, and a victim advocate who is there to provide emotional support, referrals, and information to the victim.

Trauma Intervention Programs (TIP) of San Diego, Inc.

Also known as TIP, this non-profit volunteer-based program was developed to provide support and assistance to those traumatically affected in emergency situations. When a trauma occurs, partnering agencies such as law enforcement, fire, and hospital personnel request a TIP volunteer to be with survivors to provide much needed emotional and practical support immediately following the crisis. TIP San Diego is an affiliate of TIP National.

Program services are provided free of charge, and there is no legal citizenship requirement to receive assistance. The San Diego District Attorney's office has assigned skilled Advocates to many Victim Assistance Centers located at eight centers throughout San Diego county.
